1.1 Case No. AR-23-09

Frances & Ken Ray, 1670 Lands End Rd., requests approval to paint the exterior of the home and replace exterior lights. The exterior walls and trim of the house will be painted Behr Ultra-Pure White 4050. Lighting to be replaced includes Fresno Long Wall Sconces (Visual Comfort #CHD 2936AI-CG0) consisting of a rectangular shape glass enclosure with black metal frame, 500 lumens per unit to replace existing light fixtures on each side of the front entryway. A hanging globe shaped pendent lamp is proposed to replace and existing hanging lamp within the front entry and will consist of a globe light surrounded by a brown woven synthetic wicker shade, 2064 lumens (Bover BVR2224562).

1.2 Case No. AR-23-10

George Mattson, 69 Curlew Rd., requests approval for new hurricane impact rated garage doors. The 4 existing garage doors will be replaced by aluminum bronze framed doors which incorporate four horizontal white laminated glass inserts (Eco Series E850-12).
